

What to do when a client passes away

Any user who has knowledge that a client in the cluster has died should edit the Client Vitals and update the Client State field to indicate the client has passed away. The steps below outline how to complete the task.

NOTE: You must enter a minimum of three characters to execute a search. You may search by a client's first, middle and/or last name. The less you enter the better the chance to find an existing name. For example, for "Shelley Smithers" you could enter "She Smi". 7. Click the Search button to find the client's record.

14	Save X Cancel	◆ NOTE: Changing Client State to 'Deceased' will end the client's consent record effective on the Date of Death or the date the record is updated if there is no Date of Death. Users from service providers with a service transaction in the client file will have read-only access to the record; however, any other users will no longer have access to the record.
